

Curriculum Rules and Regulations for Undergraduate Program

According to the Common Required Course regulations of College of Management at National Chiao-Tung University, all the undergraduate students are required to take compulsory courses offered by the College of Management in compliance with their current academic year and course schedule. Students whose study plans can not comply with the course requirements mentioned above should apply for the approval. Special conditions agreed by the Curriculum Committee of each department are not under this regulation.

1. Volunteer learning I and II are compulsory courses, but cannot be counted in the minimum required graduated credits.
2. Regulations for retaking and summer course are listed as following:

i. Retaking Course Regulations:

- Students(single major, second major, double major, credit program in college of management) whose initial common required courses selection should choose courses offered by college of management.

Students who wish to retake the common required courses from the college other than the college of management should get approval from the course conveners of college of management, and submit the consent to the department office. Thus, the earned credits can be counted in completed ones.

Selection of courses offered by University System of Taiwan shall be subject to the approval of the department curriculum committee and submit the consents to the college of management committee. Thus, the earned credits can be counted in completed ones.

ii. Summer Course Regulations:

Students whose initial common required courses selection is not allowed to take summer course.

Students(single major, second major, double major, credit program in college of management) who wish to retake the common required courses from the college other than the college of management during the summer vacation should get approval from course conveners of college of management and submit the consent to the department office. Thus, the earned credits can be counted in completed ones. For students who wish to take course from a university other than NCTU, they can only take courses that are given by the University System of Taiwan.

Students who cannot meet the requirements mentioned above should get approval from college curriculum committee. Thus, the earned credits can be counted

in completed ones.

3. The related application forms of retaking course and summer course selection are available on-line via official department website.
4. The required credits for double majoring students are 35. If students completed more than 35, those exceed 35 are treated as elective credits but are still counted in completed credits for graduation.
5. "Calculus for business I and II" are available for college of management students. Students can still select "Calculus I and II" for personal preference. However, "Calculus for business I and II" may not be successfully transferred when students apply for "transferring" to the other departments. The course is lectured by professor Ching –Tung, Wu and is designed for Department of Management Science students. Compared to the common Calculus course, abstruse mathematical proofs are removed in the course design and financial/economic relevant mathematic tools are included instead. Also, the textbook and syllabus are different from the common Calculus I and II. The department of management science affairs meeting has reached agreement upon the course design mentioned above.
6. Since the 101th academic year, freshmen and sophomores are required to take one credit "Mentor Time" course. Two hours are required for this course. It is not included in credits for graduation. This rule is suitable for all freshmen enrolled NCTU since 101th academic year.
